INFORMATION CONCERNING PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING

According to art. 14 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation, hereinafter the "GDPR"), the Jagiellonian University informs that:

3. Your personal data has been obtained from public sources: website, specialist press, etc.
4. Your personal data will be processed in order to submit and execute the request for selection of the contractor based on art. 6 sec. 1c of the General Regulation, and in the event of an offer being selected and conclusion of a contract pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1b of the GDPR.
5. Providing your personal data results from the provisions of law, and in case of selecting an offer is a condition for the conclusion and implementation of the contract.
6. Failure to provide personal data in the event of selecting an offer will make it impossible to conclude a contract.
7. Your personal data at the stage of the inquiry will not be made available to third parties, and in case of conclusion of the contract will be made available to entities authorized to receive it on the basis of legal provisions.
8. Your personal data will not be transferred outside the EEA and / or international organizations.
9. Your personal data will be kept for the period provided for by law.
10. You have the right to: access your data and rectify it, as well as the right to remove, limit processing, transfer data, object to processing - in cases and on the conditions specified in the GDPR.
11. You have the right to lodge a complaint to the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection if you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the GDPR.
